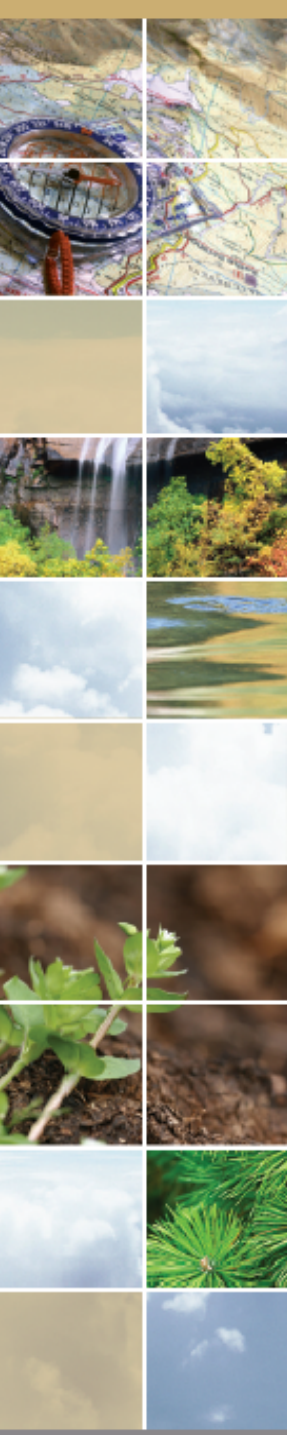
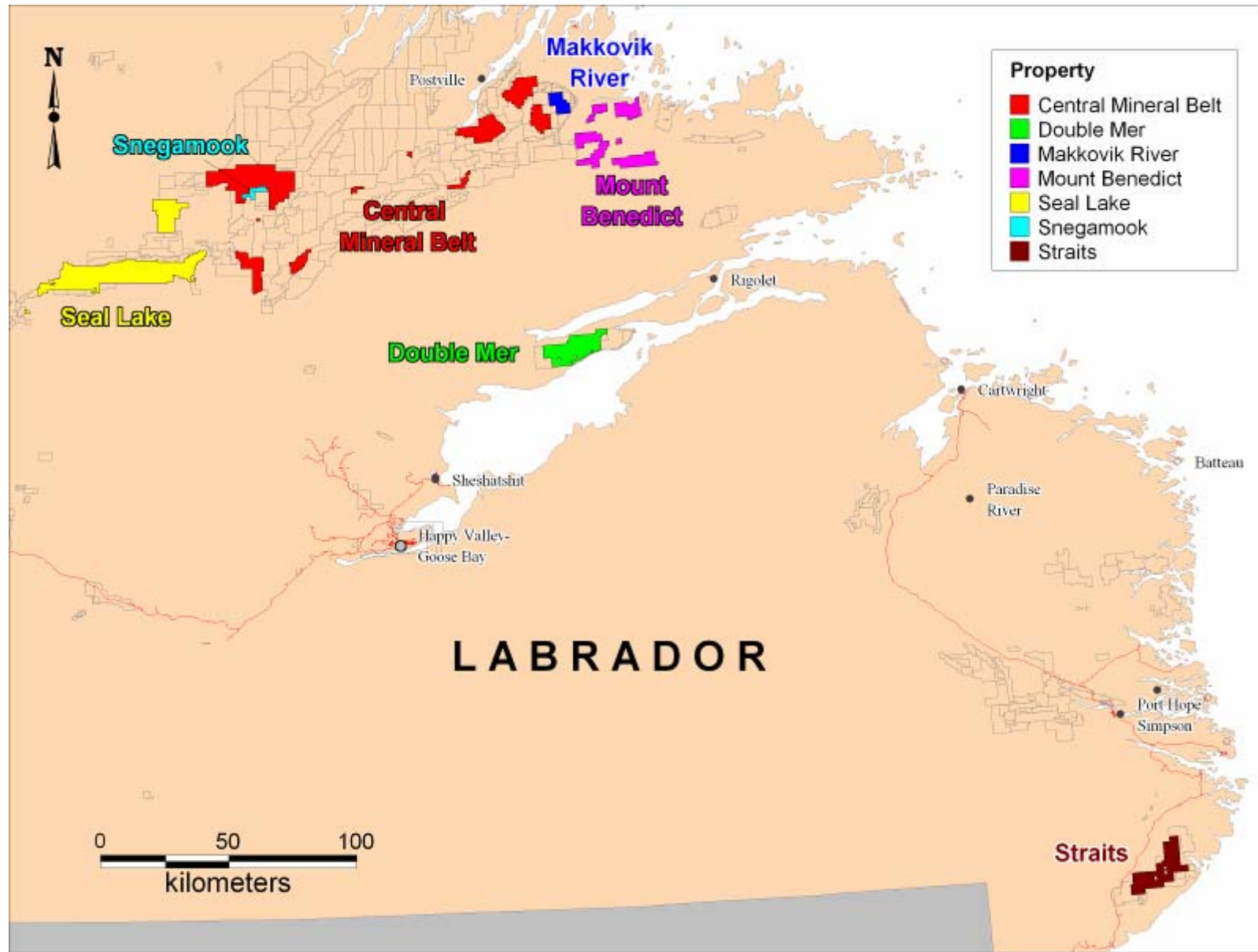

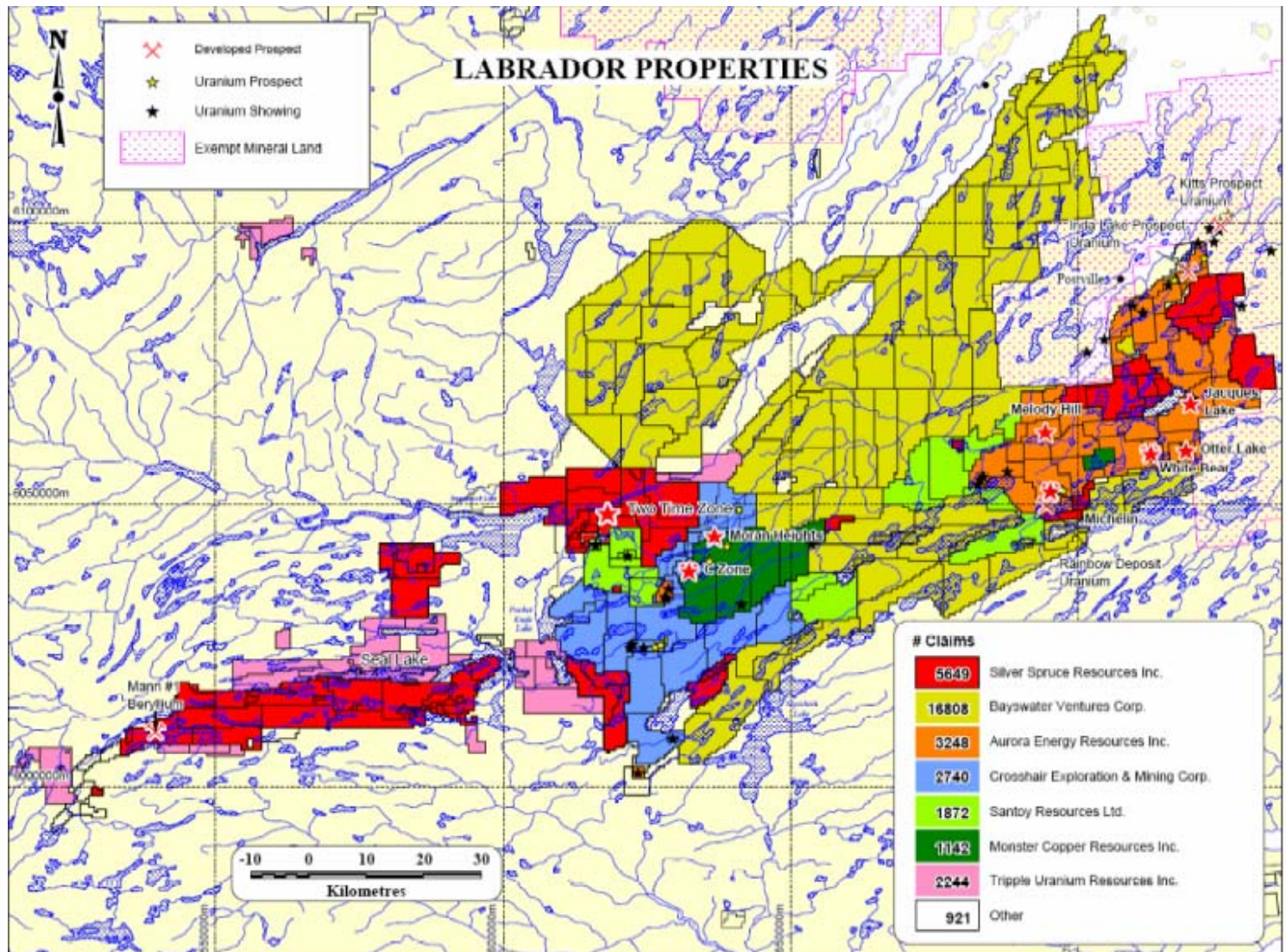


Silver Spruce Labrador Properties

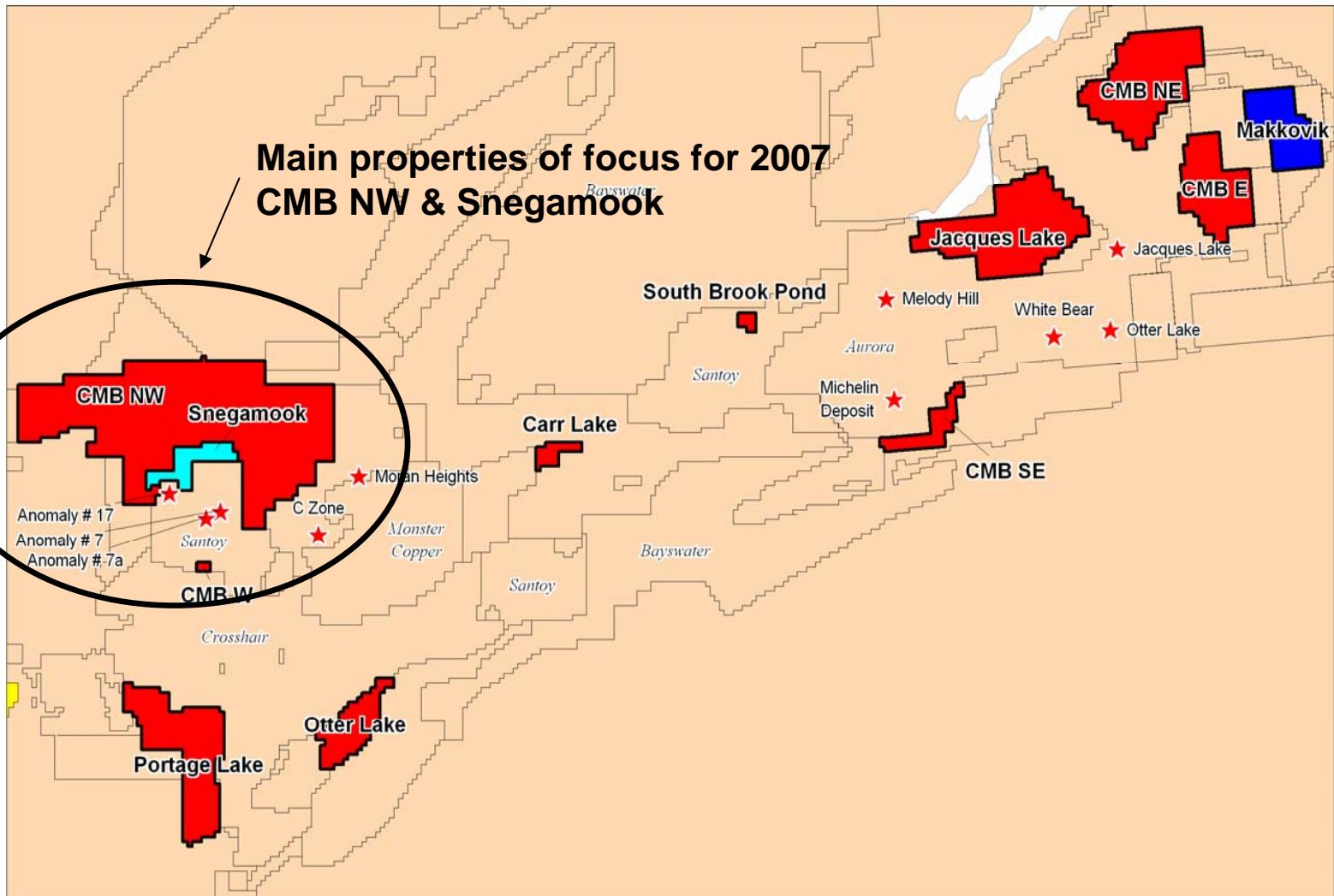


Central Mineral Belt Explorers

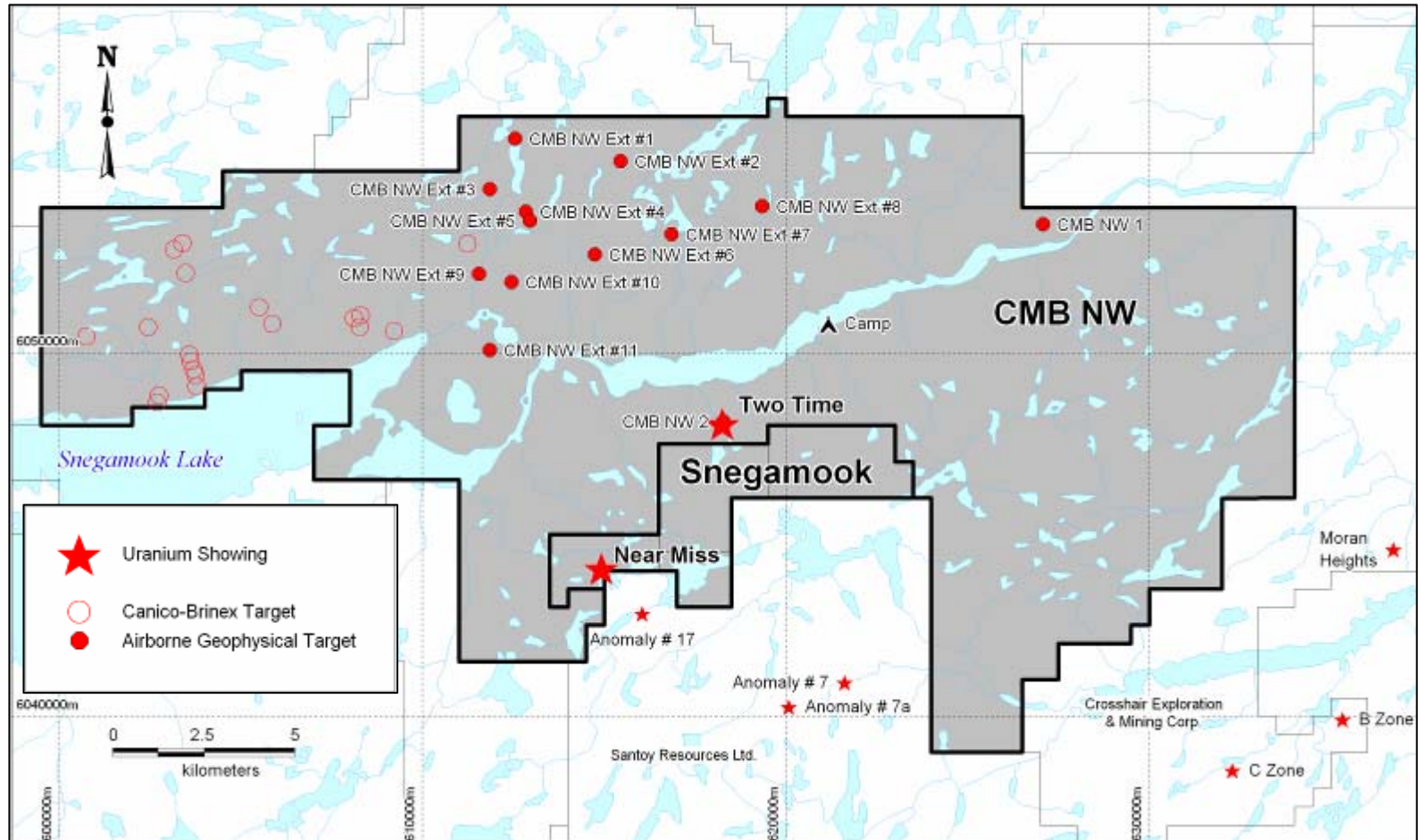
Proximity to other more advanced explorers--surround Aurora & Crosshair on three sides

CMB Northwest – Radiometric Anomalies

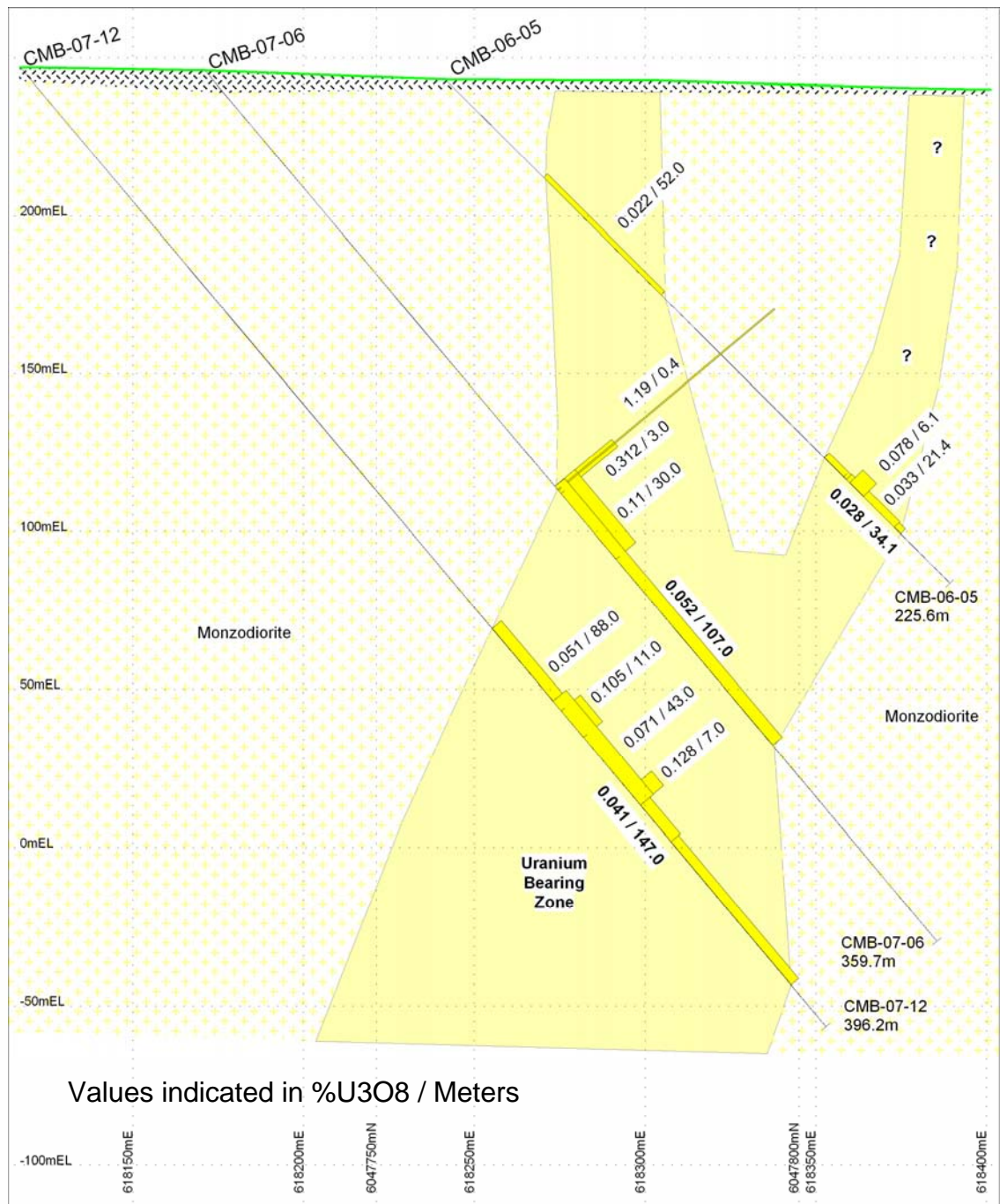
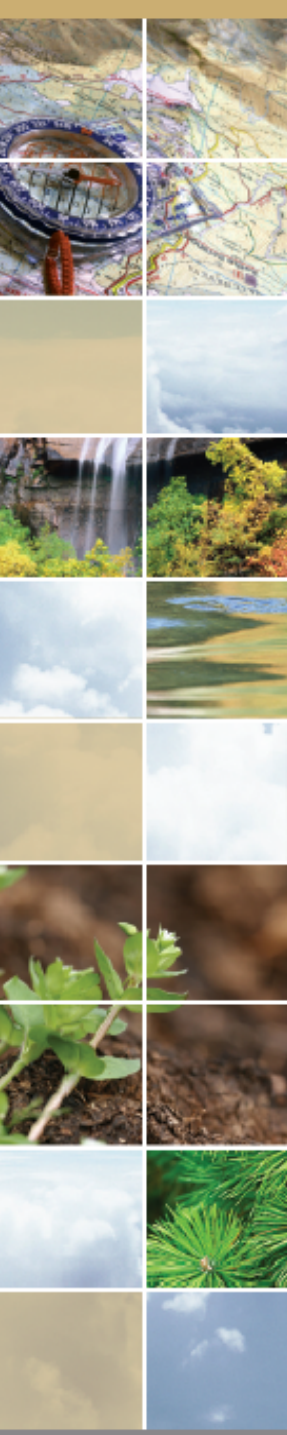


Many Geophysical targets to follow-up on during 2007 field work.

First Drill Target: Two Time Zone

- Large surface target of 300m X 50m
- Two drill programs completed comprising a total of 12 holes and 3,254 m
- Highlights of programs include: 11 of 12 holes hitting mineralization, 107 m of 0.052% U_3O_8 , 147 m of 0.041% U_3O_8 , 30 m of 0.11%
- Two other parallel zones that may be associated and cover a distance of more than 6 km
- 8,000 m to 15,000 m drill program to begin in May 2007 that will further test T Two Time, for the first time test the Near Miss and possibly the HF Occurrence

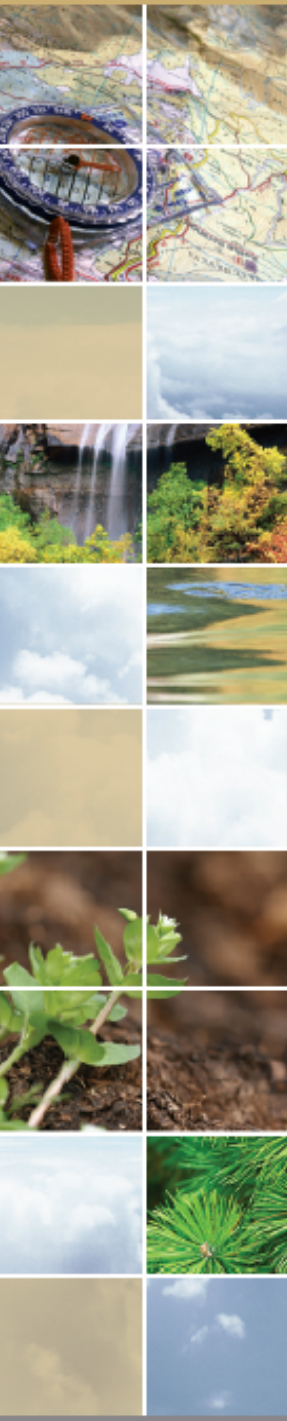

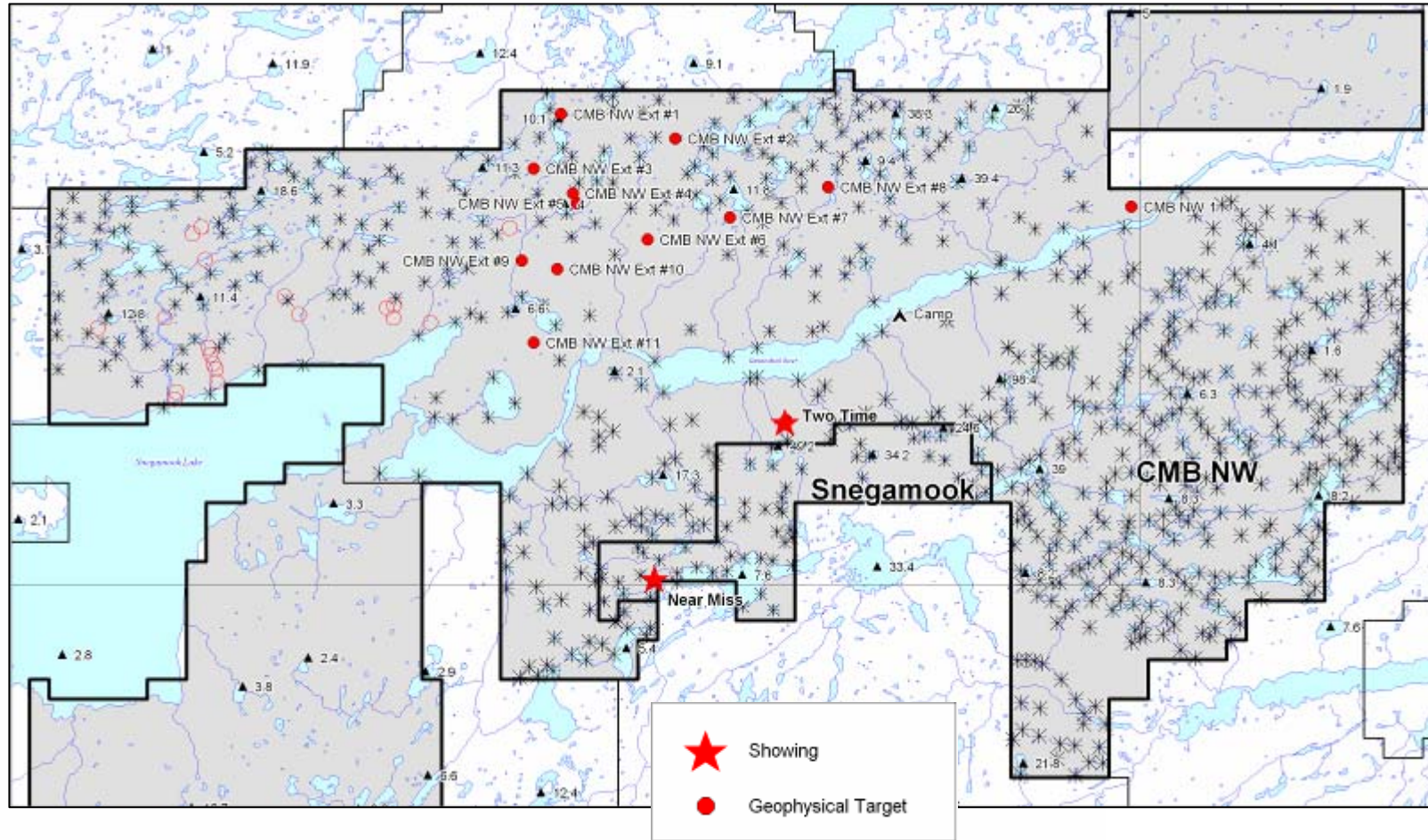

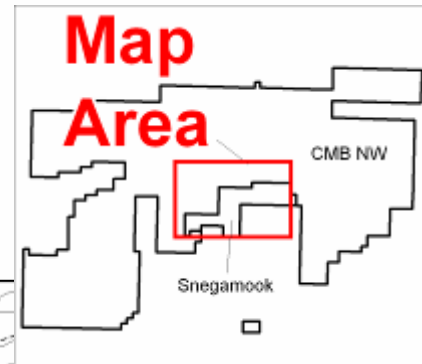

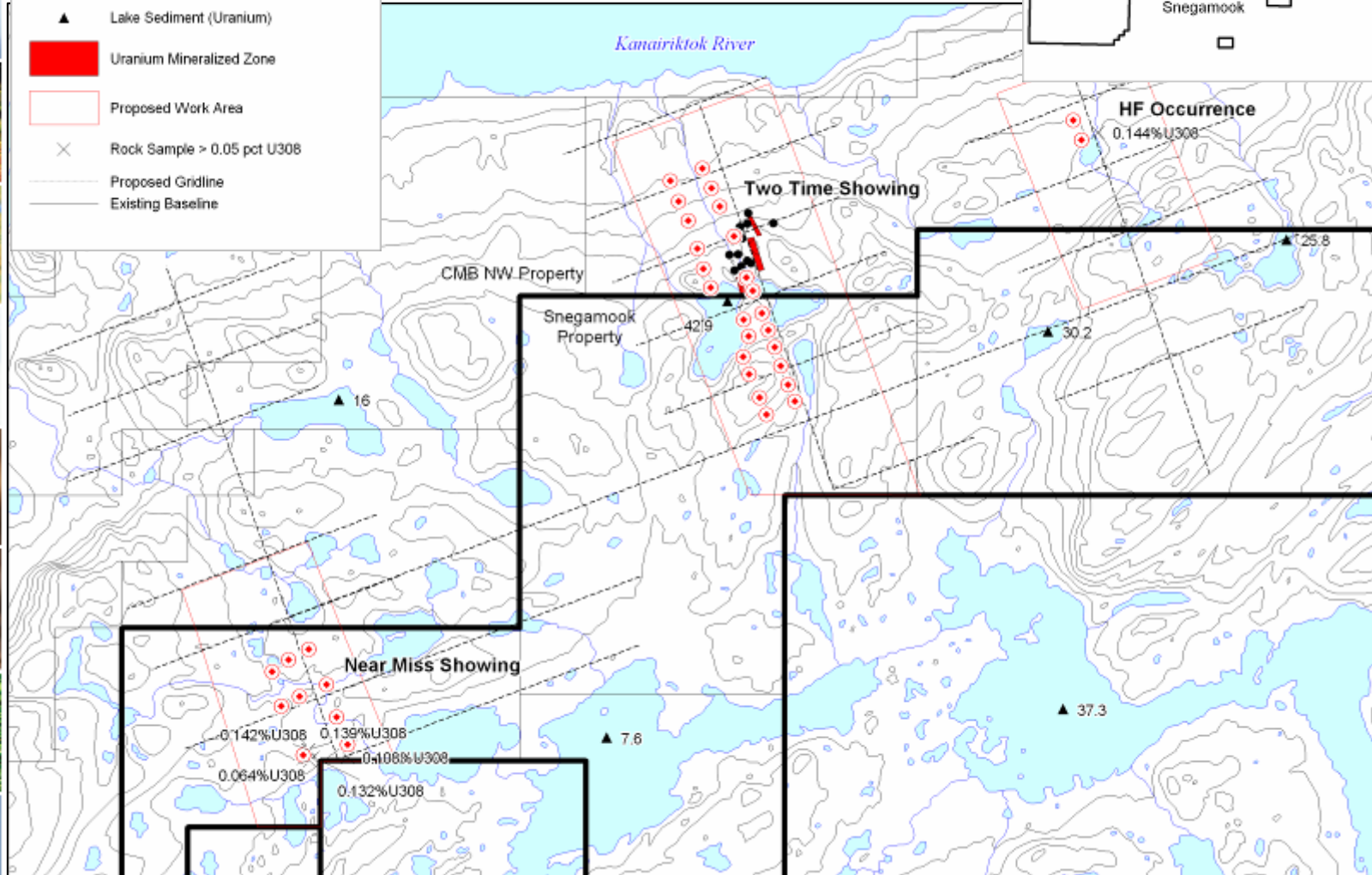
Proposed 2007 Lake Sediment Sampling

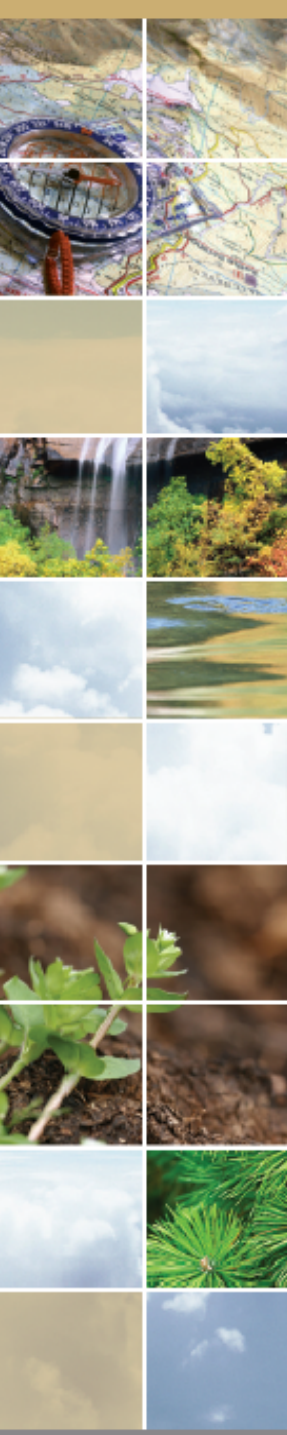
